

2020 USA Softball Bylaw Changes with Comments as of November 15, 2019

NOTE: All changes below are EFFECTIVE November 15, 2019 unless otherwise noted.

Article Number Change

Section 7.2 b 7.2. Function of the Board

b. adopts and amends the USA Softball Procedural Manual

<u>Comments:</u> Removes the board from adopting and amending the Bylaws because Section 9.2 states the Council has the authority to do it.

Section 7.2 b 7.2. Function of the Board

b. Must, at the next board meeting, consider any proposed amendments to the bylaws that a Council member submits.

<u>Comments:</u> Adds the function of considering any proposed amendments to the Bylaws the Council submits.

Section 7.2 c 7.2. Function of the Board

c. Make the final decision on any interpretation of bylaw section 14 by a majority vote.

<u>Comments:</u> Add the function of taking a majority vote on anything relation to section 14 of the bylaws. Re-letter as needed.

Section 10.17 c 10.17. Working Committees

c. Communications and Marketing Committee. This committee shall consist of at least one (1) member from the Long-Range Planning Committee and shall make recommendations to the Board (as needed) regarding all methods of USA Softball communications. This would include reviewing all current methods of communications and trends; including publications, internet, website, and all other technology areas for the association

Comments: Removes the requirement of having one member from the LRP Committee.

Section 10.17 p 10.17. Working Committees

- p. Umpires Committee. This committee shall promote the general welfare of the umpires with USA Softball. Its duties shall include but not be limited to:
 - 1. initiating an intensive program of enrolling new umpires and increasing membership;
 - 2. encouraging use of USA Softball registered umpires in all softball competition;
 - 3. encouraging every USA Softball affiliate to conduct spring rules clinics for umpires, managers and players; and,
 - 4. periodically reviewing umpire uniforms and making recommendations to the National Council for possible changes.

<u>Comments:</u> Removes the umpires from working committees because they cannot meet the 20% athlete representation per USOPC requirements.

Section 14.4 g 14.4. Responsibilities

g. Make the final decision on any interpretation of the Bylaws and Procedural Code or appoint a qualified interpreter to act in the CEO's absence.

EXCEPTION: Any interpretation involving Section 14 of the Bylaws shall be made by a majority vote of the Board of Directors.

<u>Comments:</u> Adds the responsibility of making any final decisions on the Bylaws and Procedural code with an exception to Section 14 of the Bylaws. Note: Re-letter as needed
