LOCAL TRAINING HOW CAN WE HELP YOU??

- LOCAL UMPIRE RULE CLINICS Start with rules you want to cover with power point, white board, etc. Encourage roundtable discussion. Break into groups if possible and have groups report.
- LOCAL UMPIRE MECHANICS CLINICS School agenda is developed by the RUIC in coordination with the State/Local UICs
- INFORMAL GATHERINGS AFTER GAMES Pizza Nights, etc.





INSTRUCTIONAL CAMPS, SCHOOLS, CLINICS

- UMPIRE CAMPS For both FAST PITCH and SLOW PITCH
- NATIONAL UMPIRE SCHOOLS Covers rules and mechanics of both SP & FP
 - ***We introduced a new format in 2017***
- REGIONAL UMPIRE SCHOOLS School agenda is developed by the RUIC in coordination with the Sate/Local UIC's
- LOCAL ASSOCIATION SCHOOLS and CLINICS One-day or Two-Day Clinics originated by the Local Association UIC with the RUIC who is usually invited as a clinician

HOW DO WE RETAIN?

- Mentoring system veteran umpire with a new, inexperienced umpire
- Off-field socialization pizza after games, etc.
- Rewarding the new umpire with certificates of achievement, etc.
- Helping the new umpire by providing umpire equipment new or used
- Reward (?) them for recruiting a new umpire(s)
- Be understanding of their requests for umpire scheduling

OPPORTUNITIES FOR ADVANCEMENT

As the Local Association UIC you <u>must</u> develop a plan for your umpires to advance

- Help each umpire set a goal and help them by developing a plan so that they can reach their goal.
- Get them to a National Umpire School for training and exposure to the National Staff
- Work to get them out-of-town using the Host Exchange process to get them evaluated by other UIC's (we'll talk more about this in a minute).
- Communicate regularly with your Regional UIC on the progress of your umpires;
 only the RUIC can <u>nominate</u> an umpire for an At-Large National Tournament slot.
- Work with the RUIC to get your umpires to the ELITE status and beyond.





OPPORTUNITIES FOR ADVANCEMENT

Using the HOST EXCHANGE process to get more umpires to National Tournaments

Example: A Local Association umpire may be approved to work a National Championship as a host umpire through an agreement between the Local Association's Commissioner and the hosting Commissioner of the National Championship.

Providing transportation help for the HOST EXCHANGE umpire

<u>Example</u>: Host Exchange umpires must provide their own transportation (expenses) to and from a National Championship, so asking for some help from the Local Association Commissioner, or Regional Commissioner, might be possible.





OPPORTUNITIES FOR ADVANCEMENT Getting More Umpires in National Championships

Starting the process of recruiting umpires for a National Tournament EARLY!

<u>Example</u>: Umpires are unable to get time off work, or change family vacation plans, so if the assigning is not done early the Local UIC may have a difficult time finding Host umpires who are available to work.

Increase the # of games by reducing the umpire factor

<u>Example</u>: Instead of using a 6-person umpire schedule (for 3-person games) use a 5-person umpire schedule; instead of using a 4-person schedule (for 2-person games) use a 3-person umpire schedule.





OPPORTUNITIES FOR ADVANCEMENT

Allowing ONE umpire position to be split between TWO umpires

<u>Example</u>: ONE umpire would commit to working the first three days of a Championship, another the last four days (neither umpire would be required to take an entire week of vacation from work).

Allowing HOST UMPIRES to work evenings (work part time)

<u>Example</u>: This would allow the full-time umpires to still work 3-4 games a day with additional umpires taking the last couple of games of the evening (allows full-time umpires to rest & be ready for the next day).





OPPORTUNITIES FOR ADVANCEMENT

• Umpires can now work (code change) multiple National Championships

<u>Example</u>: ONE umpire could work a SP National Championship and a FP National Championship in the same year. Multiple championships should be in different divisions of play, and we should NOT take away opportunities from other umpires.

Umpire pay for National Tournaments HAS INCREASED!

Example: FP umpires now (code change) earn a minimum of \$40 a game and SP umpires now earn a minimum of \$30 a game. The increase in minimum pay may also increase the number of umpires who can now afford to work a National Championship, creating more opportunities for advancement.
