#### b. Construction Update

Craig Cress updated the board on the status of the stadium construction. The City of Oklahoma City and Construction team is fully aware of where we are and where we need to be. The stadium should be available for use by the 2019 Women's College World Series (WCWS). We will continue to keep everyone updated and provide a live stream to watch the construction progress.

#### c. Council Meeting Update

John Miller announced that Andrea (Dre) McKee has taken over the responsibilities of running the 2018 USA Softball Annual Council Meeting. He also gave an update on the Governance Site and how it continues to be an asset in understanding how our council will vote on proposed code, rules and procedures prior to the annual meeting.

#### 9. NEW BUSINESS

#### a. 2019 NCAA WCWS

Craig Cress spoke on the impending dissolvement (by Jan. 31, 2019) of Oklahoma City All-Sports and how this will create new partnership opportunities with the City of Oklahoma City as it pertains to the Women's College World Series and other potential events.

For 2019, USA Softball feels that we can host the WCWS and that the Oklahoma City Convention and Visitors Bureau (CVB) will take care of or make arrangements for the banquet, hospitality, and merchandise. Craig Cress will look at the long form agreement from the NCAAA and see how all of this will be facilitated.

#### b. <u>WBSC Updates</u>

Craig Cress provided an update on the current state of the WBSC and changes that continue to be made in regards to naming, divisions, events, etc. He will attend the WBSC BOD meeting in Nov. 2018 and Jan. 2019.

## c. <u>USOC Assembly</u>

John Gouveia spoke about his experience at the Sept. 2018 USOC Olympic Assembly. This was a great opportunity to talk with other National Governing Bodies (NGB) about their programs. We are also currently working with the USOC on the USA Softball By-Laws in order to be recognized as an Olympic Sport.

SafeSport allocations will be increased to all NGBs for 2019.

During the USOC Olympic Assembly, USA Softball received the Diversity and Inclusive Award for having the largest increase in the diversity of our program among all NGB'S.

#### d. Logo

Codi Warren presented the BOD with three (3) examples of the proposed, standardized National Championship logos for 2019. These standardized logos will be made available at no cost. She also addressed that local customizations would be possible at an additional fee. The BOD requested some additional changes to be made and brought back to the BOD for review.
