Tournament Guidelines (From A-Z)

Admission: There will be a \$10 per person admission fee for this event. There will be no charge for players, coaches, or team staff. There will be no charge for parking. There will be precautionary bag checks (please see clear bag policy at the end of this packet. Teams are allowed one ice chest consisting of only hydrating refreshments – Coaches will receive a cooler sticker at check-in.

Cleats: We want to keep the facilities as sharp as possible. Please encourage your athletes to take off their cleats in between games!

Concessions: Concessions will be operating. **One sealed bottle of water per Person will be allowed.** Any other food/beverages will not be permitted.

Dugouts: First/Top team listed on the schedule will be in the 1st base dugout; Second/Bottom team listed will be in the 3rd base dugout, unless dugouts are Already occupied from a previous game. There will be water coolers in the dugouts during all games. Players will need to supply their own drinking cup.

Game Balls: USA Softball will supply all game balls.

Game Start Times: Game times listed on the official tournament bracket are forfeit times. Teams should be ready to start a game immediately after the preceding game is completed. Tournament Director reserves the right to reassign fields to keep tournament on schedule.

Illegal bat: If the bat is altered or non-approved, the bat is removed from the field of play, the batter is called out and ejected from the remainder of the game.

Inclement Weather: In the event of inclement weather, the game must be resumed at the exact point where it was suspended. In the case of a weather delay, everyone in the park should follow USA Softball personnel direction on weather procedure. Look for weather updates on Tourney Machine or USA Softball's Twitter account.

Line Drills: Line drills are prohibited from taking place on the infield until the Field Crew has completely exited. There will be **NO** warmups allowed in the outfield at any time at **ALL** facilities.



Line-Ups/Coin Toss: All line-up cards will be provided. Line-ups must be turned into official scorekeeper at your designated field no less than 30 minutes prior to game time. Team listed on Top/First on bracket will be the designated as the VISITOR for that game. Team listed on Bottom/Last on bracket will be designated as the HOME team.

Playing Rules 2024 National Federation High School Softball Rule Book

Refund Policy: There will be no refunds if a team cancels or drops out once the deadline has passed (March 1, 2024). If a team cancels prior to March 1, you will receive a full refund.

- Act of God Policy: If an event is not played due to weather or any Act of God, the entry fee will be refunded in full.

Time Limits: Round Robin games will have no time limit and will play a full seven Innings unless the run ahead rule has come into effect. (15 runs after 3 innings, 12 after 4 innings, and 10 after 5 innings)

Warm-Up Areas: Teams may use the space beyond the playing field, bullpens, and hitting tunnels for warmups and long as they are not being used by the teams playing at that time. Pitchers are not allowed to warm up on the grass at any time.

USA SOFTBALL HALL OF FAME COMPLEX CLEAR BAG POLICY

The USA Softball Hall of Fame Complex (2801 NE 50th Street Oklahoma City, OK 73111) operates with a clear bag policy for all events.

The Clear Bag Policy aims to provide a safer environment for the public while allowing quicker entry into the complex. The less bags to search and the ability to easily see through the clear bag will expedite entry for all who attend.

We strongly encourage you to leave all your bags at home and travel light. If you do travel with a bag, below are the permissible bags allowed into the complex:

- Non-clear bags of 9" (L) x 7" (W) or smaller. This could include clutches, cross bodies, or fanny packs.
- Diaper bags, Medical bags, Camera bags and/or Binocular cases DO NOT have to be clear but are subject to a full inspection and will have to be classified by the gate worker as an approved bag. If the bag is approved, a tag will be provided and must be present on the bag at all times.

Prohibited bags include but are not limited to:

- . Any size purse or clutch that is larger than 9" (L) X 7" (W) or that is not clear
- Briefcases, backpacks, cinch bags, and fanny packs that are not clear and/or exceed the size restriction
- · Coolers (unless used as team cooler inside of dugout)
- · Luggage of any kind
- Computer bags/cases

This policy pertains to bags and is not an all-inclusive list of items that are prohibited from being taken into Hall of Fame Complex.

Every bag that is allowed inside Hall of Fame Complex will be checked by the gate staff. There are no provisions to check items at the entry gates. Fans will be asked to either take prohibited items back to their cars before entry or dispose of prohibited items at the entrance. Fans may continue to carry approved items without a bag (e.g., binoculars, cameras and smart phones) into the stadium.

USA SOFTBALL HALL OF FAME COMPLEX PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Alcohol, drugs, illegal substances, or any paraphernalia associated with drug use, INCLUDING vapes and all tobacco products
- Cans
- Outside food
- Animals that are not deemed to be service animals. Emotional support animals are NOT allowed.
- Bags exceeding the size of a backpack
- · Tripod Cameras; All cameras MUST be handheld
- Drones
- Tents
- Fireworks or noisemakers that produce explosive cleanups
- · Balloons, confetti, glitter
- Blow microphones or alarming noisemakers such as air horns
- Any object with stick or poles (Flag, signs, selfie stick, umbrellas, etc.)
- Laser pens/pointers of any type
- Pepper spray/Mace
- Obscene or indecent clothing
- Use of 4wheel footwear, scooters, bicycles, skateboard, hoverboard, segway
- Weapons of any type, including chains, knives, firearms and spiked jewelry.
 (Off duty officers may bring in firearm but will be given proper awareness)
- Wrapped gifts
- Frisbees, toys, footballs, or other "games" that are deemed unacceptable by USA Softball Hall of Fame Complex staff
- Any other item deemed unacceptable by USA Softball Event/Complex management



USA Softball will allow <u>ONE</u> sealed water bottle of 24oz or less per person One sports cup (Yeti, Stanley, Corkcicle, etc.) per person will be allowed, but must be emptied before entering the complex.
