

Expenses: Players are responsible for travel, lodging, meals and any other accommodations

and related expenses for this event unless otherwise communicated by your Region.

Transportation: Some regions may opt to travel together. This will be left to the degression of the

individual families. No family or player shall be penalized or charged extra for ser-

vices they did not receive.

Location: All events related to the tournament will be located at Devon Park, 2801 NE 50th

Street, Oklahoma City, OK 73111.

Arrival: All players must be available beginning on Thursday at 9:00am.

Departure: The Championship Game is tentatively scheduled for Sunday at 8:00pm

PARTICIPANT INFORMATION

Coaches: All coaches must be background checked and SafeSport Certified through

USA Softball and display their card at all times. They must present paperwork at

check-in.

Headshots: Each participant MUST submit a headshot to the tournament to be used in the

Tournament Program. Headshots must be uploaded to the tournament website.

Uniforms: Each player will be given two USA Softball All-American jerseys. Numbers will

be randomly assigned. It is the responsibility of the player to bring the following:

- White Pants; Red Socks, Navy Socks Each coach will be given two shirts.

Equipment: Each participant is responsible for their own equipment as none will be provided by

the tournament. All catchers should bring their own catchers gear. All bats will be

tested prior to any game play. See Thursday schedule for bat testing times and

information.

Team Meeting: Your team will have a scheduled team meeting on Thursday morning. This should

be used as an opportunity to get to know the girls on your team and your coaches.

Photos: There will be a professional photographer on site taking individual and team

photos. Even number regions should wear red and odd number regions wear navy,

along with their white pants and navy socks.

Team Practices: Your team will have a short scheduled team practice on Thursday. This will be used

as an opportunity for your coaches to quickly evaluate player talent and for pitchers

and catchers to get used to each other.

Opening Day Ceremonies:

Ceremonies: Thursday All activities at Devon Park

All Teams are expected to participate in opening ceremonies. Players are required to wear their Jerseys. Even number regions wear Red, Odd number regions wear

blue. Allow enough time for participants to part take in all activities.

9:00am-2:30pm- Opening Day Activities 4:30pm-5:30pm- Opening Ceremonies

Following the parade and opening marks, the top 3 finalist for each skills contest will compete for first place. 3 top scoring pitchers, 3 top scoring around the horn teams, top 3 from baserunning,

and the 3 top scoring hitters. Finals will take place on the stadium field.

Recommendation: 1-2 individuals from each team takes all bats to be tested.

Individuals arriving late must see onsite UIC to have their bat tested before any games.

Skills Competition 9:00am-2:00pm Opening Ceremonies— 4:30pm



SKILLS COMPETITIONS: Will run on Thursday from 9:00am -2:00pm

There is NOT a designated time for each team to go. Please allow enough time for participants to participate in all activities.

INFORMATION: Participation is optional, but strongly encouraged.

Players will check-in with the volunteers at each of the events and will provide their name and region they represent.

Prizes will be awarded to the Top 3 from each competition during Opening Ceremonies.

DO NOT wait until the last minute to participate!
All competitions will close at 2:00pm to prepare for Opening Ceremonies

Events:

Star Drill – Will take place on the OGE Energy Field.

- This Skill Involves 5 Players from your team.
- Team will be given 3 timed attempts.
- The best recorded time will be used for the leaderboard.
- The top 3 teams will compete during Opening Ceremonies.

Directions:

- Players will take each of the following positions: Home, SS, 1B, 3B, 2B
- The ball will start at home and will be thrown to each player in this order.
- Home throws to SS, SS throws to 1B, 1B throws to 3B, 3B throws to 2B, 2B throws to Home.
- The timer begins once the ball is released from the hand of the player at home, and is stopped once the ball reaches the glove of the player at Home.

Base Running – Will take place on the OGE Energy field.

- ◆ This is an Individual Skill
- This is a timed event from 1B to Home.
- The top 3 finishes will compete at Opening Ceremonies.

Directions:

- Players will start at 1B, they may start from any position they are most comfortable with.
- Players will be timed as soon as their foot leaves 1B, and stops once Home Plate is touched.

Pitching – Will take place in the left field pitching tunnels on the OGE Energy Field **NOTE** > **Anyone participating in this event must bring their own catcher and warm up on their own**

- This is an individual skill
- Pitchers will have a chance to throw 5 fastballs.
- The top 3 times will be used for the leaderboard.
- The 3 top finishers will compete during Opening Ceremonies.

Hitting – will take place on the Integris Field.

- This is an individual skill
- Players will hit 5 balls off a tee for distance.
- 3 of the furthest balls hit will be used for the leaderboard.
- The top 3 finishers will compete during Opening Ceremonies.

Directions:

- The tee will be set up in the center of home plate.
- Hitters may adjust where they stand in the box, but can't move the tee from the original position.
- Distance is measured from the center of the tee to where the ball initially drops.



NON-SEEDED POOL PLAY SCHEDULE



90 Min. Time limit—6 innings Max 5 Batters each 1/2 inning




SEEDED POOL PLAY SCHEDULE



Winners move to the right, losers move to the left. Seeds are determined by place in the Pod. The winner of the game on the right side of Pod is Seed 1, loser is Seed 2. The winner of the game on the left side of the pod is Seed 3, loser is seed 4.







IMPORTANT TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

Uniforms: The team in the 1st base dugout will always wear Blue. The team in the 3rd base

dugout will always be Red. Athletes need to bring both jerseys to each game

Dugouts: Players and coaches are the only individuals allowed in the dugout. The team listed at

the TOP of the bracket will occupy the first base dugout unless the team is playing

back-to-back.

Coin Flip: The home team and visiting team will be determined by a coin toss when line-ups are

turned in to the home plate umpire prior to the game.

Playing Rules: All playing rules and regulations for the tournament will be in accordance with the

current USA Softball Official Rules.

Pool Play Only

Roster Batting is allowed otherwise you will use standard USA Softball Rules

If roster batting the following will apply:

free defensive substitution

courtesy runner for pitcher/catcher will be the last out.

Game Times: All Games are 1:30, No New Inning.

Please follow the times listed on the official tournament bracket. Game time is forfeit time. Teams should be prepared to start a game immediately after the proceeding game is completed in the event that the tournament is running behind schedule.

Line Up Forms: Tournament officials will provide line-up forms for each team. Managers must use First

and Last Names and jersey number when filling out the line-up forms. You should turn

in your line-up cards 20 minutes prior to your next game.

Scorekeeping: Game Changer will be used to score keep all games. Fans from home will be able to

follow live play-by-play and real-time stats online. We are using Game Changer for the purposes of official scorekeeping and for fans to follow the game. We are NOT using for official stats. Please do not approach scorekeepers to ask about specific plays.

Livestreaming: All games will be Livestreamed through USASoftball.com pending availability.

Weather: In the event of inclement weather, the schedule will be adjusted according to the USA

Softball Code.

Heat: Oklahoma's heat is very hot and humid. Please drink plenty of water in the week

leading up to the event.

Admission: Admission will be charged Daily. Cost is \$15 per person

Children 8 & under are free. Weekend Passes will be available on site.

Advanced purchase is recommended

Souvenirs: Souvenirs will be available throughout the entire weekend.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do I have to be there for Check-In?

Yes, all players must be present for their assigned team meeting and check-in time on Thursday.

Can I request my jersey number?

No, the numbers are randomly assigned and may not be requested.

Are all the games played at the Devon Park Complex?

All games will be played at the Devon Park Complex.

Is there a gift exchange?

The athletes will be getting a USA Softball Swag Bag for their participation in the All-American Games Tournament but there will be no gift exchanges between teams since they are made up of individual players.

Will there be pin trading?

There will be no official pin trading since the teams are made up of individual players but if players want to bring their own team's pins to trade, that is up to them.

Am I guaranteed to play my primary position?

This event is made up of elite athletes from all over the country. Play time and position will be determined by the coach. You may be asked to play another position for the benefit of the team.

Who is coaching my team?

Similar to the players, each Region selected the best coaches possible to represent their region. Your coach should contact you once the regional team has been selected.

Who Should I Contact if I am not contacted by my coach?

How was it determined who played who in Pool Play?

A blind draw was used to place teams into the Pool Play Schedule. Teams were protected from playing their own Region in Pool Play.

Will we be protected from our Region in Bracket Play?

No. Single elimination bracket will be determined by the seeding from pool play.

Am I Guaranteed to Play at the Stadium Field?

Yes, all teams will play at least one game on the Stadium Field.

Is there a Fee to participate?

\$125.00 per player/coach is the cost we bill each region. Regions are allowed to charge a minimal fee for tryouts and the player fee for the event.

Players should **NOT** be denied the ability to be named or participate in the All American games, due to the inability to pay or participate in additional add on(s) the region may offer.

DEVON PARK CLEAR BAG POLICY

Devon Park (2801 NE 50th Street Oklahoma City, OK 73111) operates with a clear bag policy for all events.

The Clear Bag Policy aims to provide a safer environment for the public while allowing quicker entry into the complex. The less bags to search and the ability to easily see through the clear bag will expedite entry for all who attend.

We strongly encourage you to leave all your bags at home and travel light. **If you do** travel with a bag, below are the permissible bags allowed into the complex:

- Non-clear bags of 9" (L) x 7" (W) or smaller. This could include clutches, cross bodies, or fanny packs.
- Diaper bags, Medical bags, Camera bags and/or Binocular cases DO NOT have to be clear but are subject to a full inspection and will have to be classified by the gate worker as an approved bag. If the bag is approved, a tag will be provided and must be present on the bag at all times.

Prohibited bags include but are not limited to:

- Any size purse or clutch that is larger than 9" (L) X 7" (W) or that is not clear
- Briefcases, backpacks, cinch bags, and fanny packs that are not clear and/or exceed the size restriction
- Coolers (unless used as team cooler inside of dugout)
- Luggage of any kind
- Computer bags/cases

This policy pertains to bags and is not an all-inclusive list of items that are prohibited from being taken into Devon Park.

Every bag that is allowed inside Devon Park will be checked by the gate staff. There are no provisions to check items at the entry gates. Fans will be asked to either take prohibited items back to their cars before entry or dispose of prohibited items at the entrance. Fans may continue to carry approved items without a bag (e.g., binoculars, cameras and smart phones) into the complex.

DEVON PARK PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Alcohol, drugs, illegal substances, or any paraphernalia associated with drug use, INCLUDING vapes and all tobacco products
- Cans
- Outside food
- Animals that are not deemed to be service animals. Emotional support animals are NOT allowed.
- Bags exceeding the size of a backpack
- Tripod Cameras; All cameras MUST be handheld
- Drones
- Tents
- Lawn chairs or chairs with arms and backs
- Fireworks or noisemakers that produce explosive cleanups
- Balloons, confetti, glitter
- Blow microphones or alarming noisemakers such as air horns
- Any object with stick or poles (Flag, signs, selfie stick, umbrellas, etc.)
- Laser pens/pointers of any type
- Pepper spray/Mace
- Obscene or indecent clothing
- Use of 4wheel footwear, scooters, bicycles, skateboard, hoverboard, segway
- Weapons of any type, including chains, knives, firearms and spiked jewelry.
 (Off duty officers may bring in firearm but will be given proper awareness)
- Wrapped gifts
- Frisbees, toys, footballs, or other "games" that are deemed unacceptable by USA Softball Event/Devon Park management
- Any other item deemed unacceptable by USA Softball Event/Devon Park management



Devon Park will allow <u>ONE</u> sealed water bottle of 24oz or less per personOne sports cup (Yeti, Stanley, Corkcicle, etc.) per person will be allowed, but must be emptied before entering the complex.
